## **Uniform**

All pupils attending Kings' School are required to wear the correct School Uniform. There is no negotiation on this point. The School Uniform has been designed so that it is simple, clear, unequivocal and easily obtainable. It is, in the first instance, the responsibility of the Tutor to monitor Uniform standards. All members of staff, however, should assume a corporate responsibility in maintaining the Uniform Regulations.

It is expected that all items of Uniform marked with an asterisk \* can be purchased through the School Uniform shop. The Uniform is as follows:-

\*Black Blazer, with School Badge – to be worn by all boys and girls.

\*Charcoal grey box-pleated knee-length skirts

OR

\*Charcoal grey or black trousers – trousers should be straight legged (not skinny or tapered legs)

\*Burgundy V-neck pullover with gold trim or badge

White shirt/blouse with conventional collar to be worn with School Tie

Plain white short sleeved shirt/blouse with conventional collar (may be worn in the summer with the School Tie).

\*Burgundy School Tie with gold stripe, (worn with 6 stripes shown)

Plain Grey, Black or Natural tights for girls.

Socks – Plain School colour (black or grey with trousers; black, grey or white with skirts).

Shoes – Black 'sensible' shoes only (boots, trainers, plimsolls are not allowed)

Flat shoes only for girls (not fashion ballet style pumps)

Coats must be smart, of a single colour, with no slogans or large lettering or images and avoiding extremes of fashion

Leather or denim jackets should not be worn.

\*School scarf, (no other may be worn).

Hair must be an appropriate style for School and must not reflect any extremes of fashion and should not be dyed. Boys must not have their hair cut less than a Grade 3. Their hair must be no longer than at the collar, over the ears and above the eyebrows. Plain black hair bands only may be worn as a hair accessory for girls.

Eye make-up and nail varnish are not allowed.

Girls can only wear plain gold stud earrings in the earlobe. Boys must not wear earrings.

Necklaces, chains must not be worn.

One plain, simple ring is allowed, e.g. a Signet Ring.

Non-religious bracelets and bangles etc. are not allowed.

Watches may be worn at the owner's risk and should be engraved with the pupil's name.

School bags must be rucksack style, which distribute weight evenly and are waterproof. Pupils must not use handbag style bags. Carrier bags are not acceptable either for books or PE kit and must not be used.

Boys must be clean shaven.

Top buttons must be done up; shirts must be tucked in; skirts must not be "rolled".

## Kit for Physical Education

Girls

White aertex shirt with sleeves and collar or \*plain White T-Shirt.

\*Burgundy pleated PE skirt.

\*Burgundy shadow stripe shorts.

\*Burgundy games shirt (reversible) with 6" white band on one side.

\*Burgundy socks with white tops.

Plain white sports socks.

Plimsolls or training shoes (non-marking soles).

Hockey boots (Soccer/Rugby boots may be worn).

\*Optional grey sweatshirt with School crest.

Plain black swimsuit.

Plain black tracksuit bottoms for winter.

Boys

White aertex shirt with sleeves and collar or \*plain White T-shirt.

\*Burgundy games shirt (reversible) with 6" White band on one side.

\*Plain black shadow stripe shorts.

\*Burgundy socks with White tops.

Plain white sports socks.

Plimsolls or training shoes (non-marking soles).

Soccer/Rugby boots.

\*Optional grey sweatshirt with School crest.

Black swim trunks or swim shorts.

Plain black tracksuit bottoms for winter.

All items of clothing etc. should be clearly marked with the pupil's name.
